**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The International Flying Fifteen Class Association and International 420 Class Association rules will apply.
- 1.3 Helms may not change crew during the event without prior permission of the OA.
- 1.4 Life-jackets or other adequate personal buoyancy shall be worn by all competitors at all times whilst afloat. Wet suits and dry suits are not adequate personal buoyancy

**2 COMMUNICATION**

The Official Notice Board will be online. A link to the online Official Notice Board will be available on [www.whsc.ie](http://www.whsc.ie) before registration.

**3 IDENTIFICATION**

Subject to the approval of the OA a boat chartered or loaned for the event may declare at the time of entry or registration a sail number which may be different from the registered number of the hull provided that the number declared shall not be the sail number of any other boat competing in the regatta (References RRS 77, Appendix G).

**4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Flying Fifteen and International 420 classes, whose helm are members of their National Class Association, and in the case of the 420's the crew must also be a member of their National Class Association.
- 4.2 Entry fee: Flying Fifteens & 420s €80 per boat
- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form available at [www.whsc.ie](http://www.whsc.ie) together with payment of the required fee prior to 12:00 on Monday August 8<sup>th</sup> and thereafter a late entry fee of €100 will apply.
- 4.4 **Parent/Guardian Declarations:** Parents or Guardians of helms and crews who are under 18 years of age must submit a Parental Consent Form at event registration.

## 5. SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration will be at Waterford Harbour Sailing Club during the following times:

5.2 A briefing for both classes will be held outside WHSC clubhouse at 10:30 on Saturday August 13th.

5.3 Six races are scheduled for the 420 class, 3 races on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> and 3 races on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup>. Five races are scheduled for the Flying Fifteen class, 3 races on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> and 2 races on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup>.

The race committee may run one additional race each day to pick up lost races or anticipated lost races.

5.4 No warning signal will be made after 15.00hrs on Sunday August 23<sup>rd</sup>.

## 6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall have a valid class measurement certificate, which must be available for inspection at the regatta.

## 8 THE COURSES

The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions

## 9 SCORING

9.1 The scoring system will be the Low Point System of Appendix A

9.2 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.3 For both classes, when 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 10 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats in her class. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## 11 PRIZES

Flying Fifteen class prizes for Silver Fleet (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Place) and Gold Fleet (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place)  
420 class prizes for Silver Fleet (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place) and Gold Fleet (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place)

**12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**13 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid and adequate third-party liability insurance in line with respective class requirements.

**14 PRIVATE OR TEAM SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats shall register at WHSC clubhouse during the registration period. During racing support boats shall remain more than 100 metres from the course area, except when asked to assist by the race committee.
